



ACTING CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Acting classes are offered for all ages and abilities. Emphasis is on skill building and proper technique. Classes meet weekly starting the week of January 21, 2019 and the last day of classes is May 17, 2019. If a class is cancelled due to a conflict for the instructor we will reschedule class. Otherwise our classes run on the same schedule as Bartlesville public schools.

Tuition is \$40 per month per class.

Elementary Production Class

Grades: 1-3

In Spring 2019, students will bring the story of "Charlotte" to life through an immersive, storytelling experience. Elementary production classes are designed to teach basic acting skills to beginners. The emphasis is on stage direction, elements of story, stage presence, and movement. Students build confidence and develop the ability to speak and present in large and small groups. This class culminates in a short play performance of an original script created by the students and will prepare our littlest thespians for auditions for our spring play "Charlottes Web".

Acting Training Classes

In Acting 101, 201, and 301, students will learn stage directions, demonstrate spatial awareness, and understand how actors use the three tools of an actor: face body, and voice to prepare them to audition for major productions. Each class will culminate in a workshop performance for family and friends.
